
BOOKMARK OF DEFENCE

TOP-SECRET INSTRUCTIONS:


1. Cut along the dotted line to form a square.




2. Fold it in half diagonally to make a triangle.




3. Flip the paper over and fold the top point of the triangle so you can see the red dots.




4. Fold the two corners on the sides inward so you can also see the two red squares.




5. Unfold everything back to the original triangle shape. (Holly and Molly should still be facing down).




6. Fold again but only the top layer triangle leave the bottom straight, and the red dots unseen.



7. Fold the flaps with the squiggly line in to form a diamond, so you can see the laughing cells and the red squares beside them.




8. Do the same for both sides, you should now see both cells and both red squares.




9. Tuck each flap with a red square inside the folded upper triangle.



10. Tuck also the final top triangle, so the red dots and red squares are face-to-face inside the pocket.




11. Cut along the remaining dotted lines and your top-secret construction is ready to defend your page!






This is the imaging department, where all the special machines are that can look inside your body.
